In 1982, Louis Fabre took over the 4 chateaux with a heritage of 4 centuries. Marie, Louis's sister joined the team in 1998. In 2014, Clémence, and Paule, the 14th generation, joined the team to continue the story.

The vineyard is located in the South of France, 40 km from the Mediterranean sea, in the Corbières area, where the wind blows as much as the sun shines. Ideal conditions in Languedoc to grow organic vines.

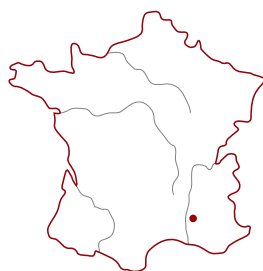

LOCATION : located on the Cruscades commune, the Chateau Coulon sits on a hill near the village.

SOIL : Clay limestone and rolled pebbles from the terrace of Cruscades.

HARVEST : exclusively manual

VINIFICATION : Vinified with whole berries for Carignan and Grenache, and a long maceration period for the Syrah and Mourvèdre. Temperature regulated maceration for 20 days.

FERMENTATION : Regular, in tank.

MATURATION : Regular, in tank.
