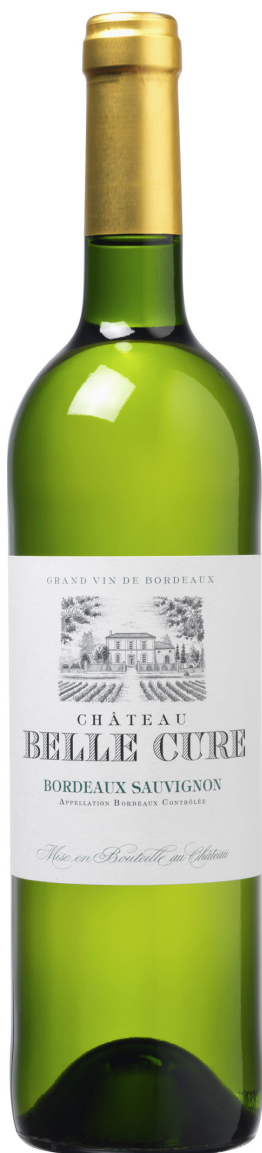

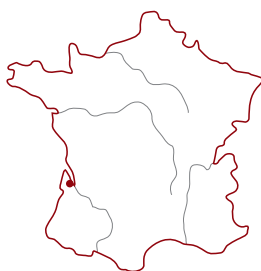

VINEYARD : 14 ha. 3300 vines/ha

SOIL : Limestone, Clay



WINEMAKING

HARVEST: Mechanical harvest.

VINIFICATION: Alcoholic fermentation at 18 to 20° after settling of the juice.

AGEING: After racking, wine is aged on fine lees in stainless steel tanks during 3 months. A cold stay in December is necessary before bottling.
