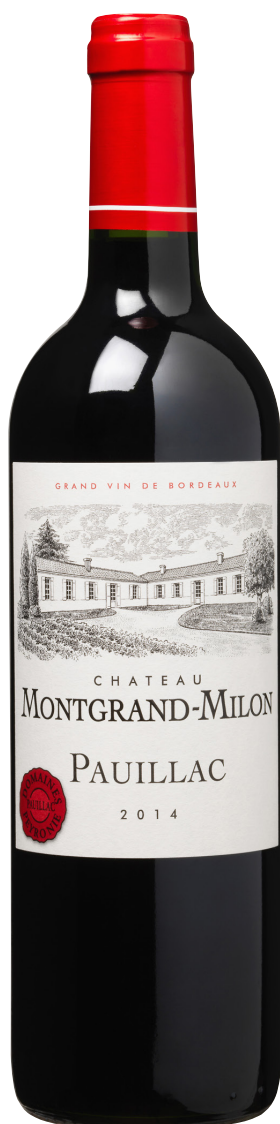


CHATEAU MONTGRAND-MILON

PAUILLAC

In the Middle Ages, the estate Château Montgrand-Milon was part of the Château Latour domain and all the evidence dating back to that period shows that vines were planted very early on, but it is only at the end of the Ancien Régime that records show a structured vineyard at Montgrand Milon.

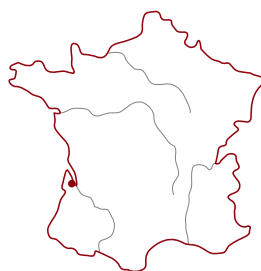

VINEYARD : 12.5 ha ; 10000 vines/ha

SOIL : Gravel



WINEMAKING

HARVEST: Manual harvest.

VINIFICATION: Vinification in stainless steel tanks with control of the temperature.

AGEING: Ageing between 12 and 15 months in oak barrels (15% renewal).

In the mouth rich, well-balanced with present and vivid tannins.
