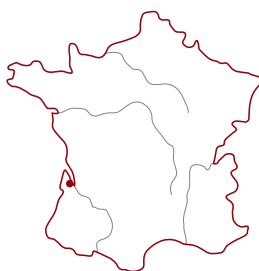

SOIL : Gravel, sand, Clay, Silt



WINEMAKING

HARVEST: Manual harvest.

VINIFICATION: Tradition wine-making process and ageing with control of the temperature.

4 to 5 weeks vatting.

Beautiful fresh nose of red fruits with a touch of violet cassis.



In the mouth, the wine is frank, round with fat. The final has ripe tanins, silky and elegant.
