

CHATEAU LA GRAVE

SAINTE-CROIX-DU-MONT Cuvée du Pin

The BRIDET family acquired Château La Grave and its 12 hectares in 1929, located on the hillsides overlooking the right bank of the Garonne in the Sainte Croix du Mont appellation area. At that time, the vineyard covered 6 hectares, 5 of which were vinified into AOC Sainte Croix du Mont sweet white wine. In 1977, the 5 ha of Château Grand Peyrot were added to the already exploited ensemble. Since 1990, new plots of land have been added to the vineyard, which now covers 25 hectares, all of which are located in the commune of Sainte Croix du Mont.

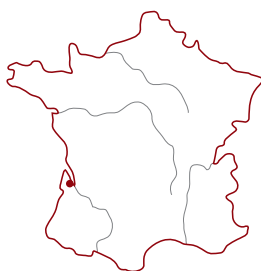
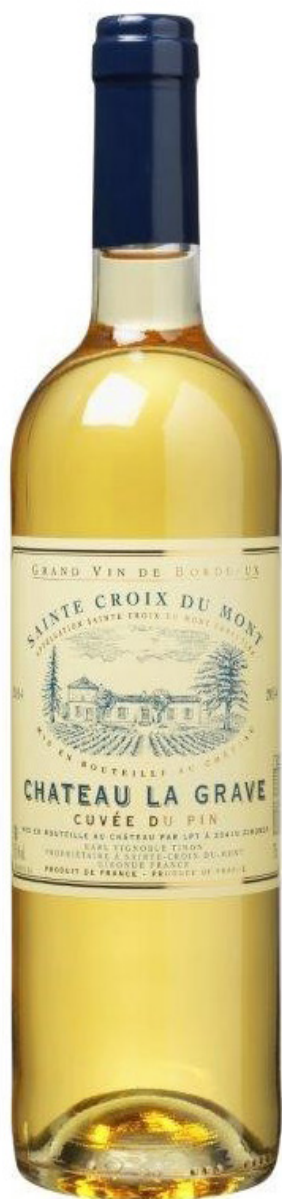
