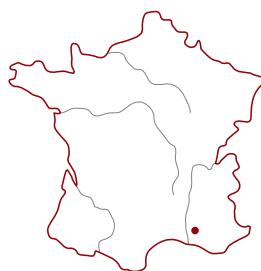

TERROIR



France is one of the most important wine growing nations in the world. The heart of its vine growing heritage is the concept of “Terroir”, which was born here.

The grapes are grown on clay-based soils, as this soil type tends to stay cooler and retain water, which is particularly well adapted to the Viognier varietal.

The terroir is also selected according to the sun exposure, as Viognier requires a lot of heat to ripen fully, and it is considered to reach its aromatic peak at around 13% alcohol content.

WINEMAKING

HARVEST : The grapes are harvested when the temperatures are cool in order to avoid oxidation and preserve freshness.

VINIFICATION : The juice ferments slowly at a very low temperature. A daily stirring on its fine lees adds complexity and pure aromas to the must.

MATURATION : The wine stays on its fine lees, under the influence of French and American oak for 6 months, enhancing the complexity of this premium Cuvée.
