

# DOMAINE DES ORGNES

## 2020 - IGP PONT DU GARD Régal de Cigale Rosé



Half way between the Provencal town of Avignon and Nîmes this family vineyard is planted on each bank of the Gard river at the most Southern part of the Côtes du Rhône Appellation. At a cycling distance to the famous aqueduc «Pont du Gard» the Domaine des Orgnes was first planted by the Roman. Nowadays Emmanuel and Michel de Gérin-Ricard enhance the potential of this charming terroir. "Cealum non animum mutò" I move under a different sky without changing soul. The generous character of these elegant cuvées remain faithful to their origin in various circumstances.

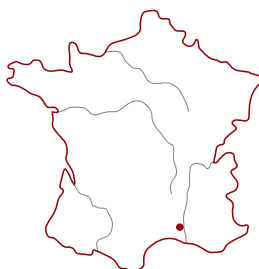

### TERROIR



**VINEYARD** : 25 hectares

**LOCATION** : Planted on the alluvial plain where the Rhône and the Gard river flow together at the foothill of the medieval village of Montrfin

**SOIL** : Rolles pebbles on limestone clay

**EXPOSURE** : South east facing

### WINEMAKING

**HARVEST** : Mechanical in early morning.

**VINIFICATION** : All bunches are destemmed, after separating the free-run juice, it is gently pressed (pneumatic).

**FERMENTATION** : After racking below 9° in thermoregulated stainless-steel vats for about 10 days below 17°C.

**MATURATION** : After two rackings, maturation on fine lees for about 4 Light filtration takes place before the bottling.
