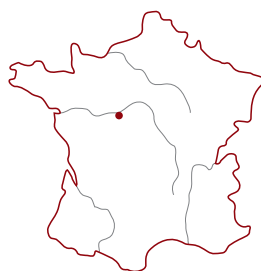

TERROIR



VINEYARD : Miltière, Haut du Thet, Bechellerie

SOIL : Limestone and siliceous loam

WINEMAKING

HARVEST: Mechanical harvest.

VINIFICATION : Pineau d'Aunis and Grolleau undergo cold maceration for 24 hours, then pressing and cold clarification. Gamay goes directly to the press. First fermentation and aging for 6 months with indigenous yeasts. Second fermentation and bottle aging before disgorgement for at least 24 months.

Dosage: 5 g/L
