TERROIR

France is one of the most important wine growing nations in the world. The heart of its viticultural heritage is the concept of «Terroir».

The term describes how a grape variety expresses itself in terms of flavour, aromas and colour, when the vines are grown in ideal conditions (well-suited soils, winds, temperatures...)

Here, the vines are located on limestone slopes, influenced by refreshing breezes and warm sunshine.

The resulting wine combines power, elegance and intensity.

WINEMAKING

HARVEST: The crop is harvested quite early in the season. Grapes are sorted and destemmed as soon as they reach the cellar.

VINIFICATION: Fermentation occurs at the controlled temperature of 26°C to 28°C. For 15 days, the juices are punched down daily in order to extract colour and tannins.

MATURATION: The wine is bottled after four months on its fine lees.
